Context

- This presentation targets <u>producers and traders</u> of Biological Plant Protection Systems/Products (BPPS)
- Van Dijk has been contracted by Eurostat to set up a sustainable market data collection system in the sector of BPPS
- Van Dijk approached IBMA's contact person to establish a collaboration
- To date the status is: <u>poor data set collected</u> mainly due to a large sensitivity in "sharing" market data expressed by IBMA and its members







Context

Principal interest of the main parties

- The European Commission wants to consolidate data to support the BPPS sector through Thematic Strategy on the Sustainable Use of Pesticides
- > IBMA wants to consolidate data through a "black box"

If nothing changes, each party will lose!

- ✓ The Commission will not have completed its primary objective
- ✓ IBMA "black block" will not be in place and credibility of the sector will be affected (transparency) at EC level (DG SANCO & ENV)
- ✓ The contractor will be financially penalised by noncompletion of its tasks

Is it a lost cause or can we COLLECTIVELY turn it into a "win-win" situation?







Diagnostic

The confidentiality of sensitive commercial data is a main issue for IBMA in three ways

- Quantitative data production, import, export, sales should not be divulged to any third party
- > IBMA itself should not access the data of (some of) its individual members
- Members of IBMA should not access the data of other members

The process of data gathering should not be fully entrusted to a third party with no control exercised by IBMA as regards its members

- ➤ IBMA would/could prefer to contact its members itself to invite them to collaborate to the survey
- Moreover, IBMA had the objective of implementing its own data collection system and developing its own database

EUROSTAT complies with strict rules concerning data protection and confidentiality (for reference)

Van Dijk has implemented a data base:

- ✓ in which the degree of confidentiality can be increased and extended to the process collection itself
- ✓ that can be thus adapted to become a "black box" system.

Both the European Commission and Van Dijk consider that there are opportunities to turn the situation around
