## China – Fast Growing & Still Developing

- Fast growing; 2<sup>nd</sup> largest economy; #121 in PPP rank
- One of the largest agrochemical producing and import/export countries
- Of > 30,000 registered pesticide products only about 650 chemicals
- Will gradually phase out highly toxic chemicals, and establish a withdrawal mechanism for old pesticides









#### **Biopesticides in China**

- Had been treated somewhat similarly to conventional chemicals in data requirement
- A revision is underway
- Current definition of the Special Pesticides:
  - Microbial pesticides
  - Biochemical pesticides
  - Botanical pesticides
    - Seminochemicals (e.g. insect pheromones)
    - Enzymes (proteins)
    - Natural plant regulators and insect growth regulators
  - Macro Pest Enemy organism
  - Transgenic organism/ GMO with anti-pesticidal activity





### **Biopesticides in China**

- Of 650 registered A.I.s, 105 are biopesticides (~16.2%)
- Of 30,000 registered products, 12% are biopesticides (and only 3% excluding antimicrobials)

### **Opportunities for Western Companies**

- The policy of phasing out highly toxic and old chemicals opens doors for biopesticides
- Currently > 80% of biopesticides registered are antimicrobials/microbials
- Most of > 2,000 agrochemical companies are conventional chemical manufactures
- Chinese government is making an effort to harmonize with OECD regulations, i.e. pesticide definitions, data requirements, GLP compliance







#### **Regulatory Differences from OECD Countries**

- Data: MOA/ICAMA requires in-China studies at authorized facilities for:
  - Product chemistry
  - Efficacy
  - > Toxicity
  - Residue
  - Environmental
- Data from OECD countries under GLP could be considered – case by case basis
- Study protocols might not be consistent with those developed by the registrants



### **Challenges – Regulatory**

Data Source	Registrants	ICAMA* laboratories and its designated testing facilities
Data Requirement	Specific & clearly defined	Certain issues could be unclear or vague
Regulatory Status	Online Publication	Online – yes & no; always double check for each registration application

### **Challenges – Regulatory**

- Published regulations might not be all current; "current" policies might not all be able to find online
- Changes may be random and based on individuals decisions
- Registration timeline case by case





### **Doing Business in China**

- Understand the regulation, culture, and politics
- Build positive relationships with regulatory agencies
- Discuss product registration or import/export issues case by case
- Find good consultants with integrity and "know how"



#### **Doing Business in China**

- Gather market intelligence & know your potential partner well before a signing contract, i.e. toll manufacturers, local agents, distributors, local employees
- Regularly audit toll manufacturers
- Be prepared to protect yourself and your products
- Beware of Intellectual Property issues
