- ~ 100 IBMA members
- ~250 registered delegates

# COM proposal for PPPs ⇒ future Reg. (EC) No 1107/2009

- In coll. with Bernard Blum: **IBMA commenting** on draft text
- Meetings with MEPs and their parliamentary assistants
- IBMA tried to introduce option for specific regulation for biocontrol products
  - 8 dropped out in 3<sup>rd</sup> reading
- IBMA on Low-risk
  - @ introduced limitation of "sensitising" criterion to chemicals
  - 8 failed to exclude microbials from "persistence" criterion in soil

### Reg. (EC) No 1107/2009: Key innovations

#### Situation today

Basic substances → 7 (+1) substances

Low-risk concept → 5 act. substances

Candidates for substitution → Reg. (EU) No 2015/408

Comparative assessment → applied ???

Zonal system and improved mutual recognition → System is in place but complex and has many shortcomings (recognition of field data & assessments of zRMS)

- IBMA attended both events as a recognised representative of Biocontrol Industry: presentations in plenary sessions
- Dublin: Attendees identified & acknowledged shortcomings ⇒ solutions
- COM strongly committed to improving Zonal System & M R

Chair: COM Participants: 5 MSs, IBMA, Experts (case by case)

Recognised IBMA status based on expertise, scientific arguments & work-sharing

<u>In general</u>: Consensus on conclusions & document

Always: Final decision by regulators and note taking in SC PAFF



#### **EU WG on BioPesticides**

#### GDs already issued

- Assessment of the equivalence of TGAI for identical microbial strains or isolates
- Semiochemical a s used in PPPs

#### Present subjects include

- Template for assessment of MOs/ possibility of read-across at higher taxonomic level
- Non-viable micro-organisms

#### Future subjects include

- Issues from OECD-Kemi-EU WS on microbials
- GD for assessment of Trichoderma spp



### **EU Working Group on Low-risk**

Initially: Broad approach favoured by DG SANCO

In the following: Split between

- Working group: Proposals for amended LR criteria
  - → Presentation in this session by Wolfgang Reinert / DG SANTÉ: "The low-risk substances and products – where now"
- Political level: Stakeholder initiative for specific LR approval procedure
  - → European Parliament Luncheon on Low-risk Pesticides Co-organised: IBMA & Copa Cogeca



### Increasing role of Efsa

- Creation in 2002
- Efsa involvement 

  Assessment of act. subst. (Peer-review & Conclusion)
  - ♦ MRL setting
  - → Presentation UH on Efsa and List-4 at ABIM 2012

Numerous **issues raised by Efsa** in conclusions, "Critical areas of concern", include for

- MBCAs: Extrapolation between strains, exposure models, sec. metabolites
- SCLPs: Background exposure
- Botanicals: Lacking endpoints for reference values; background exposure

### Nagoya Protocol – Access Benefit Sharing

Implementation Reg. (EU) No 511/2014
 Access to Genetic Resources and the Fair and Equitable Sharing of Benefits Arising from their Utilization in the Union
 Entering into force (NP & Reg.): 12th Oct. 2014

**Scope**: Depending on interpretation, all 4 groups of BCAs could be covered **Microbials! Botanicals!** Clarity for **Invertebrate** BCAs? **Semiochemicals?** 

- © Could create considerable barriers for development and use of Biocontrol products.
- Impracticability of current provisions: reference collections!
- (3) Implementation Reg. for compliance monitoring pending
  - → IBMA RegSem 2014 & 2015
  - → ABIM plenary 2014 (Johannette Klapwijk)

#### Conclusion

- ✓ Increasing awareness and understanding of specificity of biocontrol agents and products by evaluators and regulators
- ✓ Active participation of IBMA in WG of international organisations with Regulators and Evaluators
  - improved guidance
  - still locked into existing legislative framework for PPPs (EU!)
- ✓ IBMA is recognised and respected as partner by stakeholder NGOs: industry, farmers, environmentalist ⇒ collaboration and joint action
- √ Meetings and Hearings with Legislators
  - ⇒ Long way to changes in EU PPP legislation and procedures for biocontrol substances and products but we are on the right track!
