Organisation

- IBMA is governed by the Board and the Executive Committee that receives its power by delegation of the General Assembly of members
- The General Assembly elects a president, a vice president and a treasurer that together with the Executive Director form the IBMA Board
- The Executive Committee is composed of the members of the Board, the Professional Group chairs and two National Group representatives


The Research Institute of Organic Agriculture




- 1st <u>scientific</u> research institute in organic farming (1973).
